

CUP COMPETITION RULES

BRIGHTON COLLEGE CUP

1. The Competition shall be known as the "Brighton College Cup", and shall be open to Clubs competing in the Intermediate Division of the Brighton, Hove and District Football League.
2. The entrance fee shall be £7.00 payable before 1st September, or as notified by the Brighton, Hove and District Football League.
3. The Management Committee shall have entire control and management of the Competition.
4. The ground for ties shall be decided by ballot, but in the event of a Club not having a ground available, the Clubs concerned may mutually agree upon another ground, or failing this, the match shall be played on the other Club's ground.
5. Clubs drawn first in the ballot, upon whose ground gate-money is taken, shall not be liable for the fares of a non gate-taking Club. But if drawn against a gate-taking Club, the fares shall be charged upon the gate, so far as proceeds permit, according to Cup-Tie Rules. Clubs taking a collection shall not be construed as gate-taking Clubs.
6. No player shall represent more than one Club in this Competition in one season.
7. The qualification for players shall be in accordance with the Main Competition Rule 8. The use of substitutes shall be in accordance with Main Competition Rule 10(G)
8. The Trophy shall be returned in good condition to the satisfaction of, and when requested by, the Honorary Secretary. (refer to Main Competition Rule 18 B).
9. The Referee's Fee and expenses for all matches other than the final tie shall be in accordance with Main Competition Rule 13 E.
10. The Management Committee shall have the power, at any period, to strike out from this Competition any Club which by reason of its engagements, lack of playing facilities, or suspension by the Sussex County Football Association is liable to delay unduly the progress of the Competition. (Any Club proposed to be struck out shall have an opportunity of stating its case before the Management Committee or duly appointed_Sub-Committee).
11. Any Club failing to fulfil a Cup engagement or playing an unqualified player, may, at the discretion of the Management Committee_be struck from this Competition and shall be liable to a fine not exceeding £100 and may be ordered to pay any reasonable expenses incurred by their opponents to whom the match may be awarded. Such expenses shall be subject to the approval of the Management Committee_and shall be paid through the Honorary Treasurer. Where applicable the Rules of the Main Competition_shall apply to this Competition.
12. If the scores are level in a match at the conclusion of normal time, a minimum of 20 minutes and a maximum of 30 minutes extra-time shall be played. If the scores are level at the conclusion of the period of extra-time, the winners will be determined by the taking

of kicks from the penalty mark in accordance with the International Board contained in the Laws of Association Football.

- 13 Should a match be abandoned at any time, it may be ordered to stand as a completed match or replayed at the discretion of the Management Committee
- 14 The reporting of results shall be in accordance with Main Competition Rule 11
15. The Management Committee shall fix the ground, date and time of kick-off for the final tie thereof and shall have direct control of the arrangements connected with the match.
- 16 In the final tie the proceeds shall be taken by the Management Committee_who shall defray any expenses as usually allowed therefrom.
- 17 In the final tie, in addition to Cup Rule 7, players shall have played for their respective Clubs at least four times in the Brighton, Hove and District Football League in the current season.
- 18 The League shall award 16 mementos to the winners and runners-up of the final tie. the Clubs concerned may order up to five additional awards at their own expense, providing application in writing is received by the Honorary Secretary by the 15th May each year. The appointed Referee, Assistant Referees and 4th Official shall also receive mementos for the final tie.

PRESIDENTS CUP

1. This Competition shall be known as the "Presidents Cup" and shall be open by invitation to teams competing in the Intermediate Division of the Brighton, Hove and District Football League.
2. All other Rules shall be in accordance with the Rules of the "Brighton College Cup" except that the entrance fee shall be payable as notified by the Brighton, Hove and District Football League.

A.W. BRIDLE KNOCK-OUT TROPHY

1. This Competition shall be known as the "A.W. Bridle Knock-Out Trophy" and shall be open only to Clubs competing in Division 1 of the Brighton, Hove and District Football League.
2. The entrance fee shall be £5.00, payable before 1st September, or as notified by the Brighton, Hove and District Football League.
- 3 The remaining Rules shall be as for the "Brighton College Cup".

JOHN WHITTINGTON JUBILEE CUP

1. This Competition shall be known as the " John Whittington Jubilee Cup" and shall be open only to Clubs competing in Division 2 of the Brighton, Hove and District Football League.
2. The entrance fee shall be £5.00, payable when requested by the Brighton, Hove and District Football League
- 3 The remaining Rules shall be as for the "Brighton College Cup".

GENTRY BOWL

1. This Competition shall be known as the "Gentry Bowl" and shall be open only to Clubs competing in Division 3 of the Brighton, Hove and District Football League.
- 2 The entrance fee shall be £5, payable when requested by the Brighton, Hove and District Football League.
- 3 The remaining Rules shall be as for the "A.W. Bridle Knock-Out Trophy".

CORONATION CUP

1. This Competition shall be known as the "Coronation Cup" and shall be open by invitation to teams competing in Divisions 1,2 and 3 of the Brighton, Hove and District Football League
- 2 The entrance fee shall be £5, payable when requested by the Brighton, Hove and District Football League
- 3 The remaining Rules shall be as for the " John Whittington Jubilee Cup".

SUPPLEMENTARY TROPHY

1. This Competition shall be known as the "Supplementary Trophy" and shall be open to Clubs competing in the Brighton, Hove and District Football League. The Clubs which would compete in this Competition would be determined by the Management Committee prior to the operation of the Competition in any season.
2. The entrance fee shall be decided by the Management Committee
3. As per Rule 3 of the "Brighton College Cup".
4. The ground for ties shall be decided by the Honorary Fixtures Secretary.
5. The teams competing in the Competition shall be divided into groups as decided by the Management Committee. Each team shall play the other members of the group once only. Points will be awarded as follows:- 3 points for a win and 1 point for a draw. The team having scored the highest number of points in each group shall be declared the group winner. In the event of two or more teams finishing level on points, the position shall be decided by goal difference. Should such be the same, the team scoring the most

goals shall take preference. The winners of the groups shall play for the Trophy on a knock-out basis. In the event of this final being drawn, a minimum of 20 minutes and a maximum of 30 minutes extra-time shall be played. In the event of a draw after extra-time, the winners will be determined by the taking of kicks from the penalty mark in accordance with the International Board Decision contained in the Laws of Association Football.

6. No player shall represent more than one Club in this Competition in one season.
7. As per Rule 7 of the "Brighton College Cup".
8. As per Rule 8 of the "Brighton College Cup".
9. The Referee's Fee for all matches other than the final tie shall be in accordance with Main Competition Rule 13 E.
- 10 All other Rules shall be in accordance with the Rules of the "Brighton College Cup" with the exception of Rule 12.
